Notice for Re-Examination Registration for Even Semester

Applicable to FY, SY, TY, B. Tech/B. Planning and FY, SY M. Tech/M. Planning only

The Re-Examination of even semester courses will be conducted from **29th May 2026** onwards. You may refer website for Re-Exam Time Table.

The **Registration for Re-examination** is scheduled on **26th May, 2026**.

Students willing to register for the re-exam should go through the registration process in three steps as follows.

1. Pay the fees online on the link <https://www.onlinesbi.com/> and take print out of the receipt. Amount may be calculated @ Rs. 500/- per course. Please keep ready the transaction number, date and amount of the "Fees Paid Receipt" without which MIS System may not record registration done by you.

2. Please update the payment details in MIS through following link:

Just updating payment details does not confirm your registration. Hence follow the next step noted below

Please note students, paying the re-exam registration fees do not confirm your registration for re-exam. You have to complete your re-exam registration in MIS, and then only your re-exam registration is complete.

All concerned students are advised to register for the courses of their choice on the link given above on the registration date itself i.e., **Date: 26th May, 2026 Time: 10.30 AM to 05.00 PM** strictly, follow the timings.

Students absent during ESE due to medical reasons and willing to appear for re-exam, need to take recommendations from faculty mentor, then Head of Department and approval from Dean School of Engineering and Technology along with attached proofs of medical reasons.

The approved application must be submitted to the Examination and Evaluation Cell on or before **May 25, 2026**.

Detained, dropped, absent {*except medical cases approved by Dean School of Engineering and Technology*}, defaulter, copy case, cases of 'Admission Cancelled', etc., all such students are not allowed to register for re-Exam.

UG-FY, SY, TY & PG-FY, SY - Re-examination will be conducted for all courses.

Final Year UG - The re-exam is allowed for theory and elective courses; however re-exam will not be allowed for lab courses, Honor courses, Minor courses and courses of zero credit courses.

In case you face any problem during MIS Re-examination registration, write an email to mishelp@coeptech.ac.in mentioning your MIS number and course name.

Compulsorily, send your fees paid receipt to examcell@coeptech.ac.in before 3.00pm **26th May, 2026**.

Payment Mode: online only

Fees to be paid well in advance @ Rs. 500/- per course. You can pay the required amount online through SBI collect today onwards till the day of registration. 'Procedure for e-payment for amounts related to Exam Cell' is given below.

Procedure for e-payment -- thru "STATE BANK COLLECT" facility of SBI

1. Please visit State Bank website <https://www.onlinesbi.com/>
2. Find and click STATE BANK COLLECT, the 6th option from left hand side on the first horizontal bar.
3. Select the Educational category and filter for Maharashtra state.
4. Find and select COEP Technological University
5. You will be prompted to proceed further
6. Please choose the option of your requirement (Re-Exam Fee) and act correctly as prompted.
7. Take the printout of the receipt for further references. And use it to submit wherever required.

Note: Paying the Re-exam fees does not mean re-exam registration. Students should register in MIS after fees payment for re-examination registration compulsorily.
